BIG THANK YOU to water users for conserving water at our flat rate this summer. It has proved to be suscessfull and we are proud of the way our city looks with pretty green grass and clean yards. Please be responsible water users; use only what you need and conserve where you can. Due to continuing increase in operation and maintenance costs, the city water and sewer charges will be increased by 3 percent, which amounts to approximately \$2.18 more per month beginning October 1.



Because our water system works over a cell signal, and due to possible disruptions in service, we ask that you not water lawns from Saturday evening, August 19th to Monday evening August 21st. This would allow conservation of water in case of an emergency.
Also we would appreciate anyone who still uses a landline telephone, and who would be willing to allow people to use your phone for emergencies in the event that we loose our cell phone service during that time, please register with Robert Strange who is compiling a list of those landline numbers.
